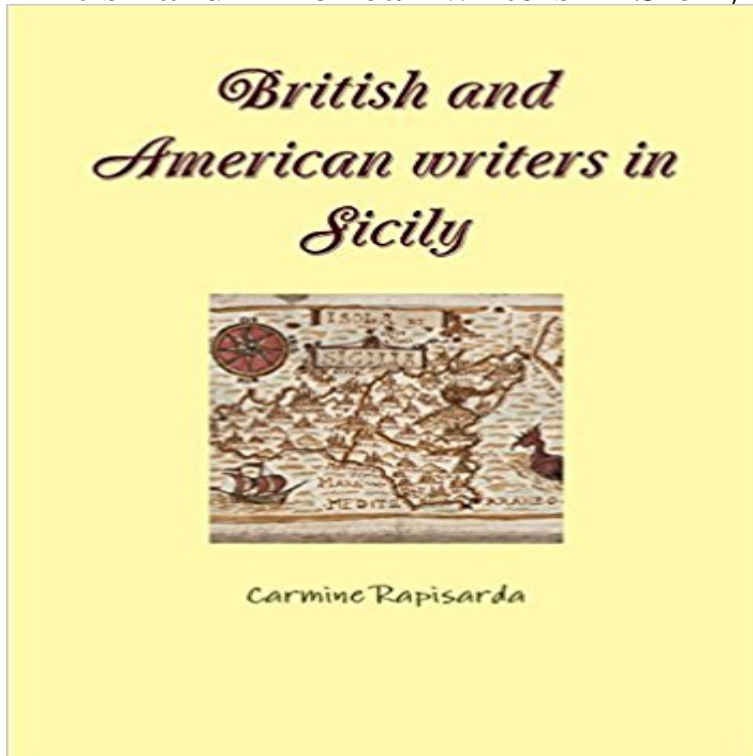


British and American writers in Sicily

The text collects a selection of travellers of Anglophone tradition such as Coleridge, Wilde, Woolf, Ruskin, Pound, Lawrence, Durrell etc. who trace original and innovative paths in the periphery of the island and in particular Taormina in the territory of Etna. Each text, taken from the original sources, is presented with a brief contextualization, historical and biographical of each author and a reconstruction of the itinerary of travel and of the main stages. In the appendix I list all the Anglophone writers who have visited the island.
