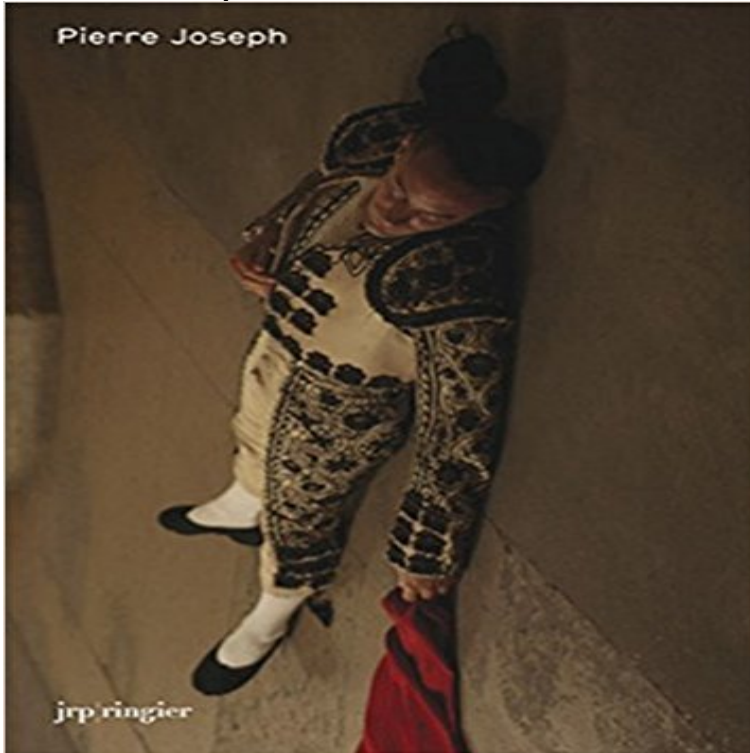


Pierre Joseph
