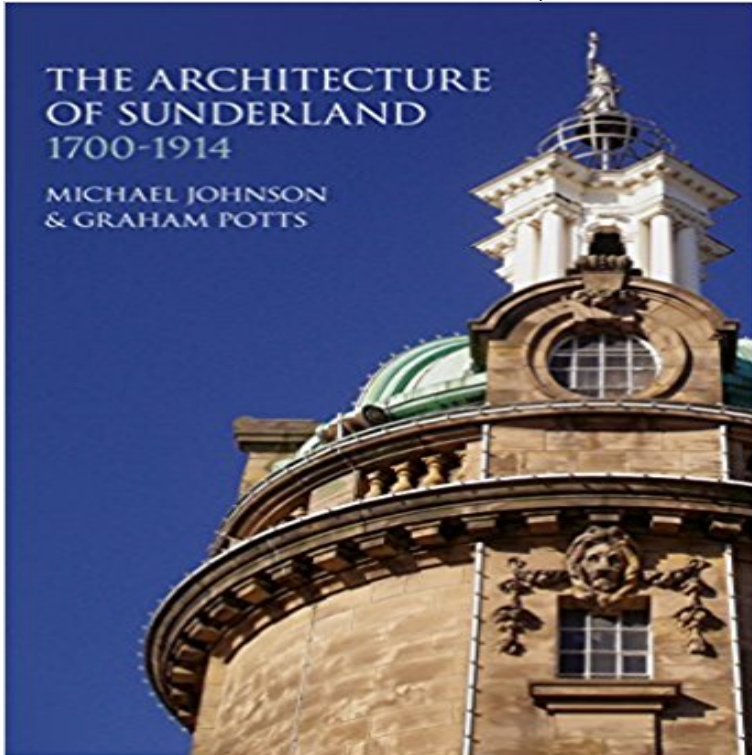


Architecture of Sunderland, 1700-1914
