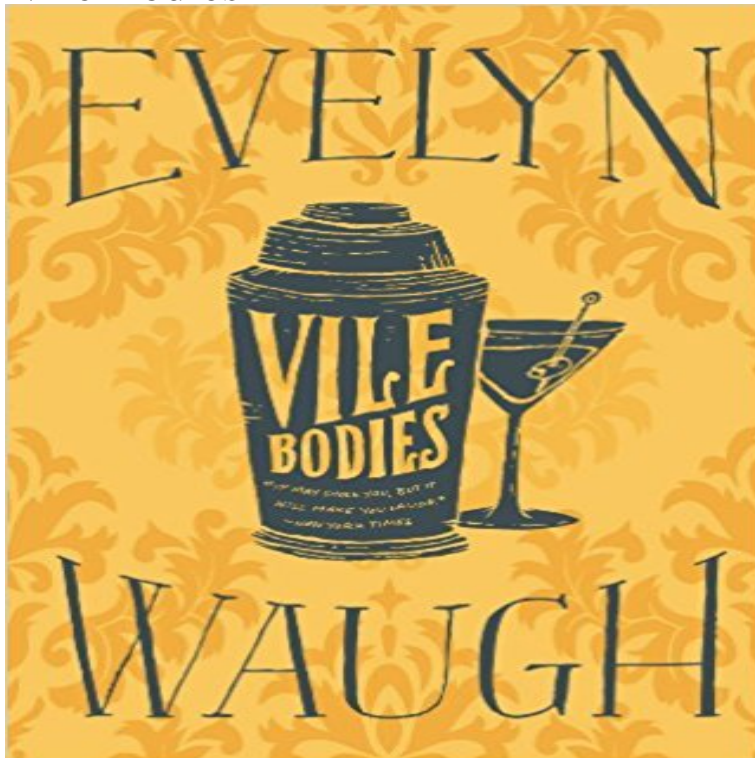


Vile Bodies
