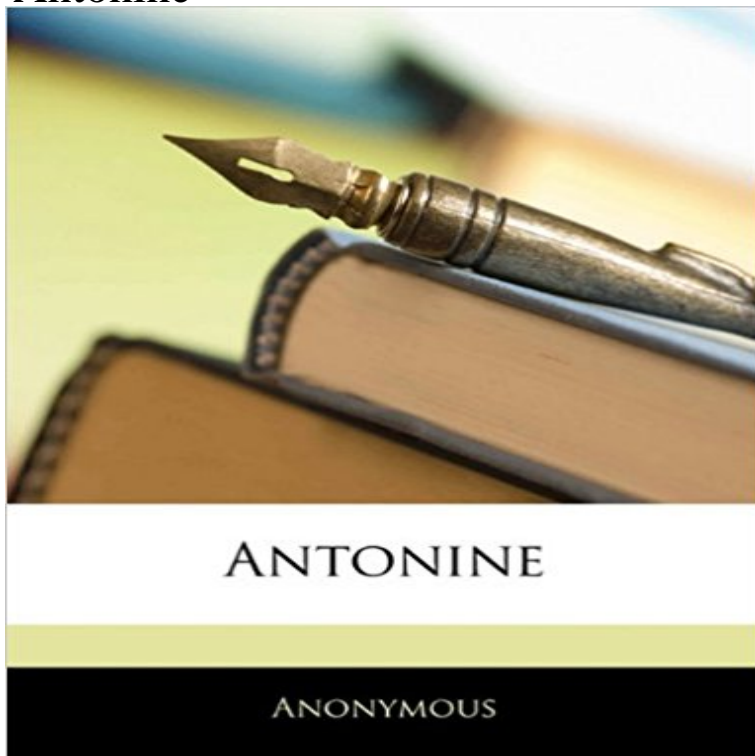


## Antonine
