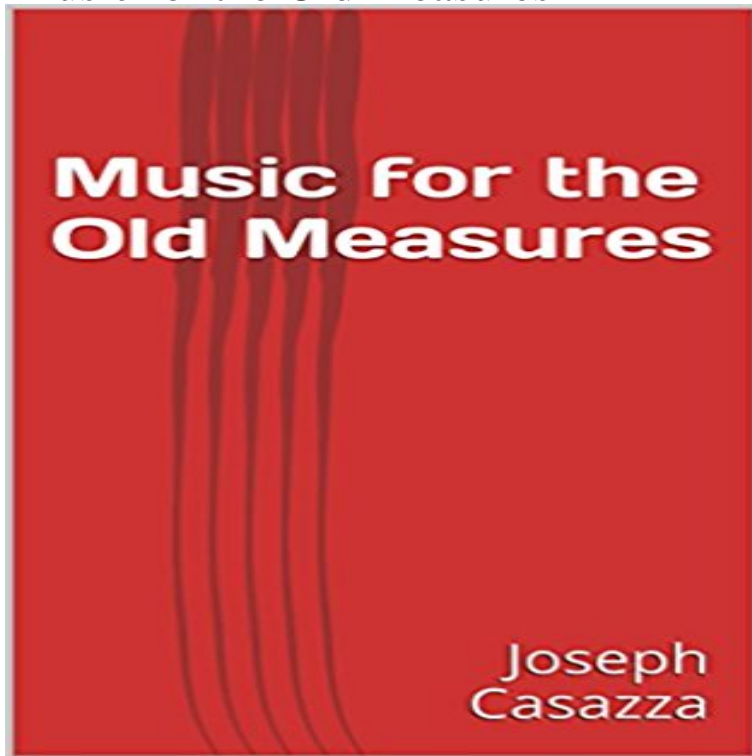


Music for the Old Measures
