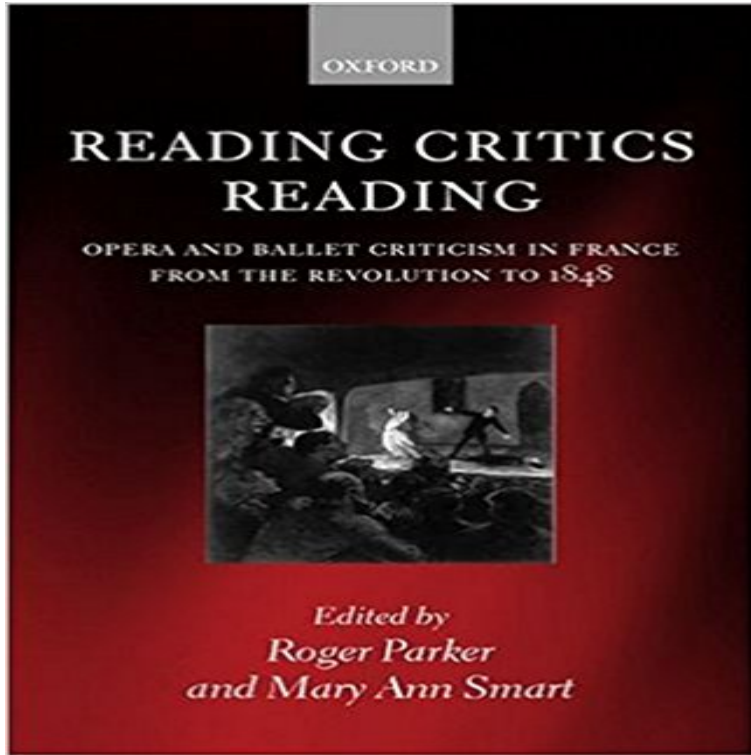


Reading Critics Reading: Opera and Ballet Criticism in France from the Revolution to 1848
