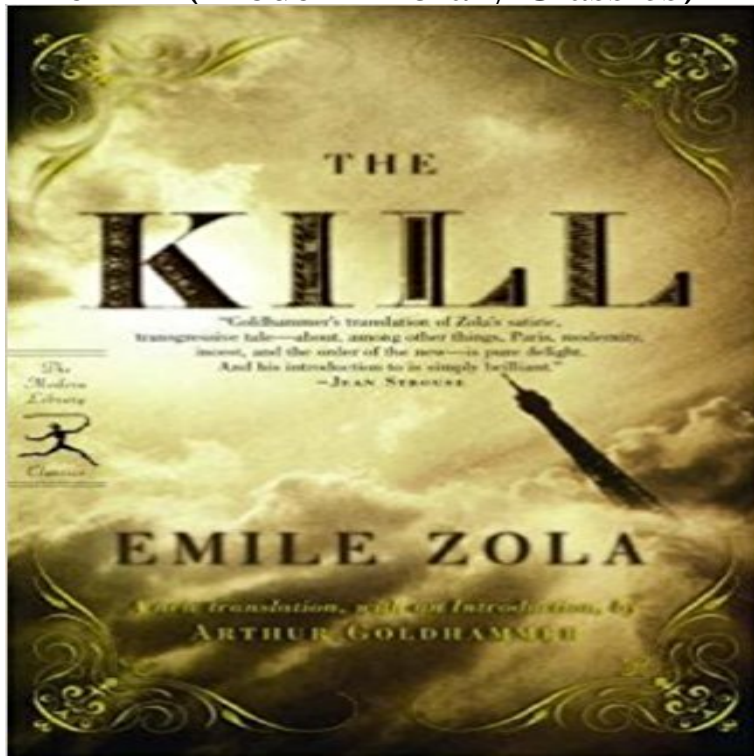


The Kill (Modern Library Classics)
