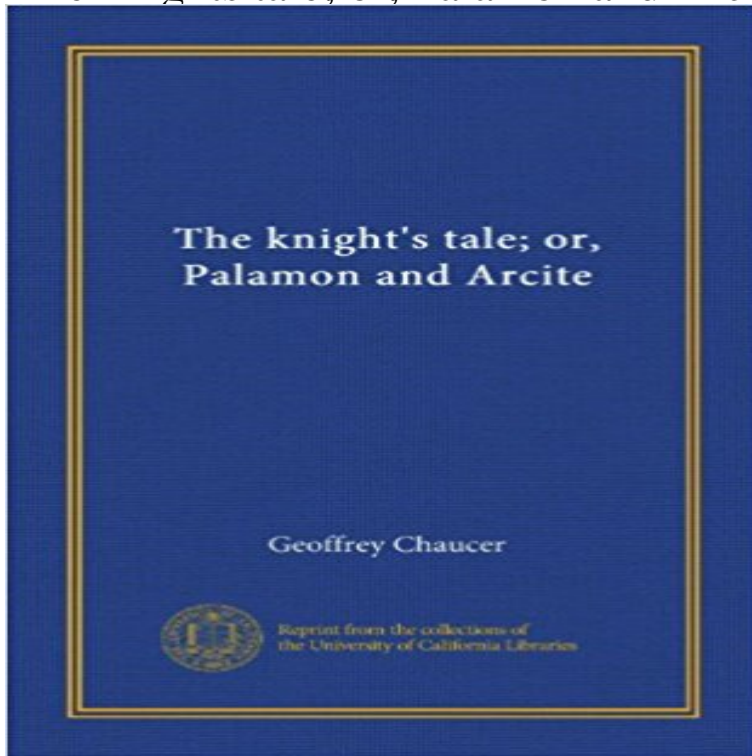


The knights tale; or, Palamon and Arcite
