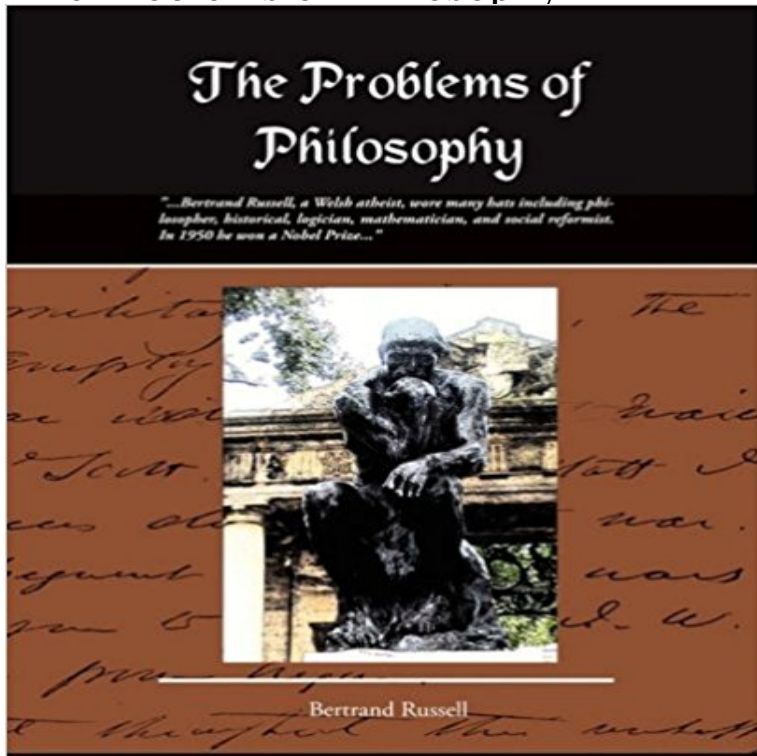


The Problems of Philosophy
