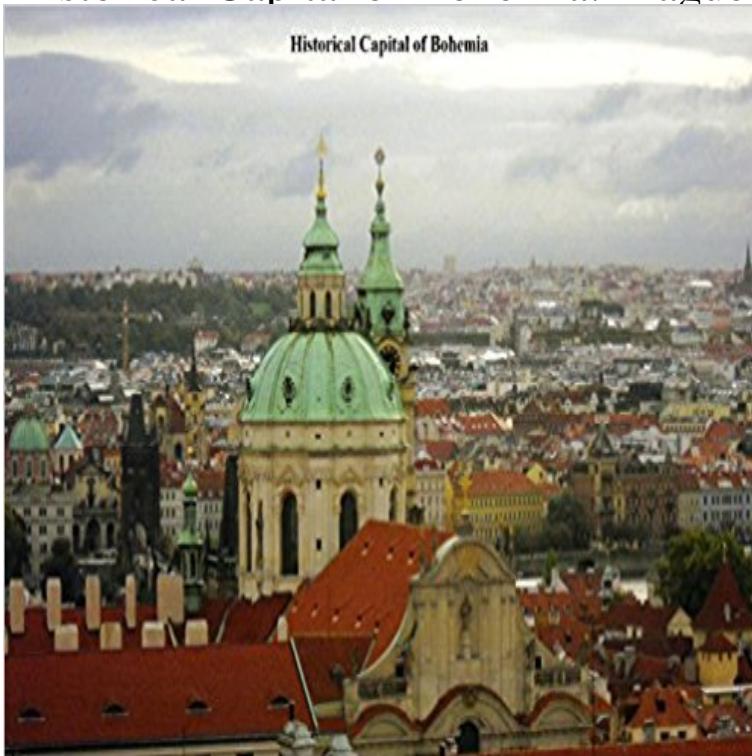


Historical Capital of Bohemia: Prague
